Lieutenant-Colonel Charles Frank Rundall. C.M.G., D.S.O., died at his home at St. Ives. Cornwall, on Sunday at the age of 80. The son of the late J. W. Rundall, of the Indian Public Works Department, he was born on June 25, 1871. He was educated at Oundle and, after attending the Royal Military Academy, Woolwich, he was gazetted to the Royal Engineers in 1891. His services during the 1914-18 war were mentioned five times in dispatches and he was awarded the D.S.O. in 1917. He had attained the substantive rank of lieutenant-colonel in 1918 and in the course of the next year was made a C.M.G. He retired from the Army in 1923. In 1901 he married Helen Agnes, daughter of Dr. R. H. Townsend. She died in 1937, and he is survived by a son and two daughters of the marriage.
