Announcement of Charles' death

CHARLES UNIACKE TOWNSHEND, of Hatley, Burlington-road, Dublin, J.P., who died June 21, aged seventy-eight, left estate (personal) in the United Kingdom valued at £30,932, of which £10,073 is English estate. By his will dated October 17, 1906, the testator left his property in Molesworth-street, Dublin, to his sons Charles Loftus Uniacke Townshend and Thomas Loftus Townshend, and he bequeathed to them each £100 ; £1,000 to his son Robert Ponsonby L. Townshend, £3,500 each to his daughters Madeline Alexandra, Anna, Martha Alice Maude, and Caroline Mary Townshend, and £100 to his assistant Henry Elliott and £50 to his assistant Isaac McAlister. The residue of his estate he left to his wife absolutely.
