Crewe Townsend, of Cork, was celebrated recently at St. Nicholas' Cathedral, Galway, the officiating clergymen being the Right Rev. the Bishop of Tuam, the Very Rev. the Dean of Tuam (cousin of the bride), and the Rev. Joyner White. The bride was given away by her father, and wore a handsome toilette of ivory satin with a deep flounce of very beautiful lace caught at the right side with a spray of orange blossoms, a chatelaine of the same depending from the left side of the waist. The bodice was held across the front and at the waist by a band of pearl and crystal embroidery, and had rucked gauze sleeves headed by big bows and tabs of satin, the former enriched with double bands of narrow pearl and crystal embroidery.
