## Announcement of his death

## SURGEON CAPTAIN TOWNSEND,

Surgeon Captain Edward Bridges Townsend. R.N., retired, of Waterlooville, Hants, died at the R.N. Hospital, Haslar, on November 7, at the age of 71. Dr. Townsend entered the Royal Navy as a surgeon on August 21, 1884, and was promoted to fleet surgeon in May, 1903, for conspicuous professional merit. He had previously served for three years as staff surgeon of the battleship Canopus in the Mediterranean. In April, 1904, he was appointed fleet surgeon of the cadets' training ship Britannia, and on the opening of the naval college at Dartmouth in the following year he was among the first officers appointed there. In 1913 he was appointed medical officer of the Vernon, torpedo school ship, in which he served during the greater part of the War. He retired in February, 1917, with the rank of deputy surgeon-general, the title of which was altered to surgeon captain in 1918.
